### The Opening

Psal. 100:3. Know ye that the LORD he is God: it is he that hath made us, and not we ourselves; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture.

Psal. 100:4. Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name.

Psal. 100:5. For the LORD is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his truth endureth to all generations.

[1.1] All praise is due to Allah, the Lord of the Worlds.

Psal. 107:8. Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men!

[1.2] The Beneficent, the Merciful.

Psal. 68:19. Blessed be the Lord, who daily loadeth us with benefits, even the God of our salvation. Selah.

[1.3] Master of the Day of Judgment.

Psal. 76:6. At thy rebuke, O God of Jacob, both the chariot and horse are cast into a dead sleep.

Psal. 76:7. Thou, even thou, art to be feared: and who may stand in thy sight when once thou art angry?

Psal. 76:8. Thou didst cause judgment to be heard from heaven; the earth feared, and was still,

Psal. 76:9. When God arose to judgment, to save all the meek of the earth. Selah.

[1.4] Thee do we serve and Thee do we beseech for help.

Isai. 64:8. But now, O LORD, thou art our father; we are the clay, and thou our potter; and we all are the work of thy hand.

Isai. 64:9. Be not wroth very sore, O LORD, neither remember iniquity for ever: behold, see, we beseech thee, we are all thy people.

[1.5] Keep us on the right path.
